"Heaven just received a star musician" Martin "Marty" Brown, aged 55, passed at home in St. Helens, Oregon on December 22, 2016.

Martin was born on June 1st, 1961 to parents Dwight and Jean (Anderson) Brown in Crescent City, California, then moved to St. Helens in 1962 where he resided for 54 years. Martin received his High School Diploma in 1979 from St. Helens High School, and pursued an Associates in Computer Programming after graduation. Although working as a computer programmer, his real passion and talent was Keyboarding, in which he performed with several bands throughout the 1980's and '90s before his health started to interfere.

Martin is survived by his brother Michael S. Brown, his sister Sheryl Kaplan, and four nieces.
