Columbia Funeral Home will be handling the service arrangements.

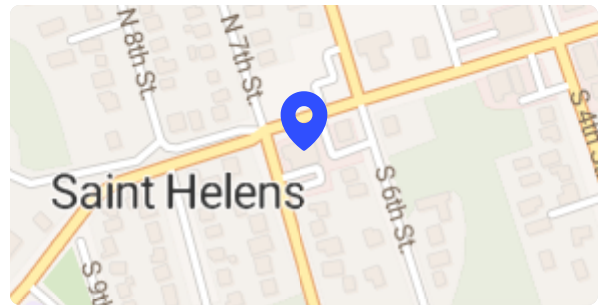

A Celebration of Life will be held at Columbia River Foursquare Church on Saturday, February 11, 2017 at 2:00 PM.



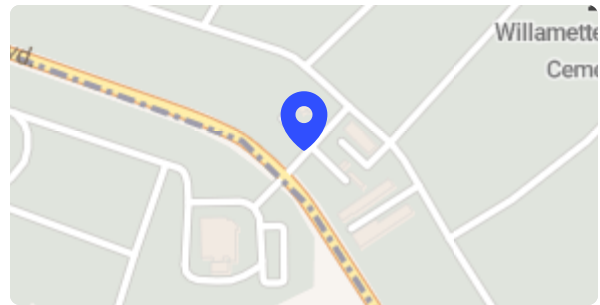
