Darwin D. Fogle of St. Helens, Oregon passed away June 20, 2019 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Portland. He was 82 years old. Darwin was born July 10, 1936 to Carl and Rosetta Fogle in Rockford, Illinois.

As a young man he earned the status of Eagle Scout, he later joined the Army National Guard. Darwin worked many years at the sawmill and served as a devoted member of his church St. Helens Missionary Baptist. After retirement he was able to dedicate 3 years to helping build the new church buildings. He was also a church camp host and a church usher and greeter for many years. Darwin was currently a member of the Cornerstone Baptist Church in Goble, Oregon.

Darwin also enjoyed elk and deer hunting, western books and movies and working outside. He was a dedicated man who loved his Lord and his family. He liked quiet and didn't want attention and he had a wonderful sense of humor.

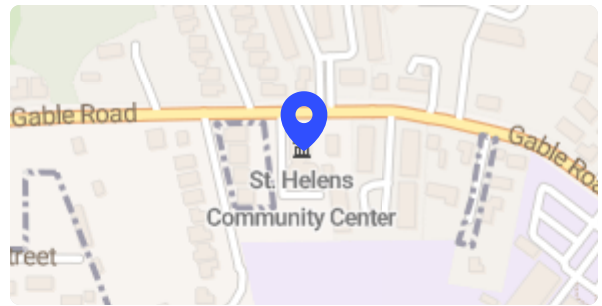

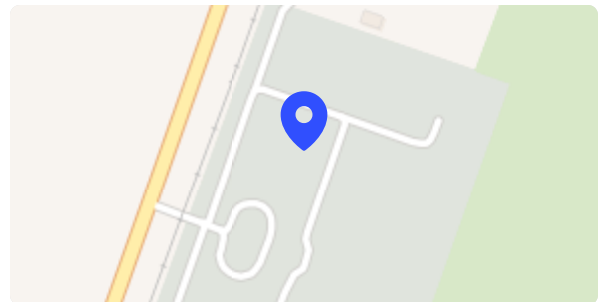
