Wayne Lee Bartlett, age 84, passed away in St. Helens, Oregon, on August 31, 2020. He was born in Minden, Nebraska on February 24, 1936. His parents were Irene and Fay Bartlett. When he was six years old his family came from Minden to St. Helens.
