Donald Andrew Fisher, age 83, lifelong residence of Scappoose, Oregon passed away quietly in his home August 17, 2022, after lengthy health issues and cancer treatment.

He was born to Joseph and Bessie Fisher June 16, 1939, in Portland, Oregon.

He graduated Scappoose High School in 1958, shortly thereafter, he was called to duty serving in the Army. Don served 3 years at Ft. Gordon, Georgia where he was trained as a dental technician. Don had many travels with friends and family throughout the years. He and his friend Tom rode their motorcycles to Mexico out of high school. He and Bonnie travelled to Europe on a delayed honeymoon. Don and good friend Nick went to Florida to watch the final launch of Atlantis STS-132 and to the Isle of Man TT motorcycle races.

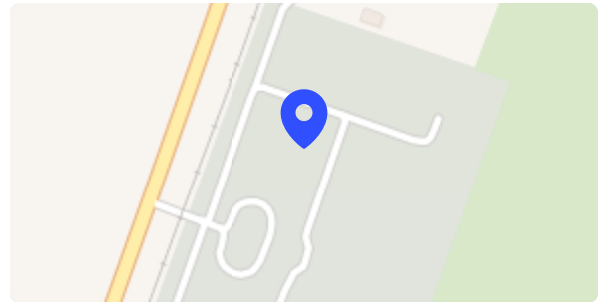

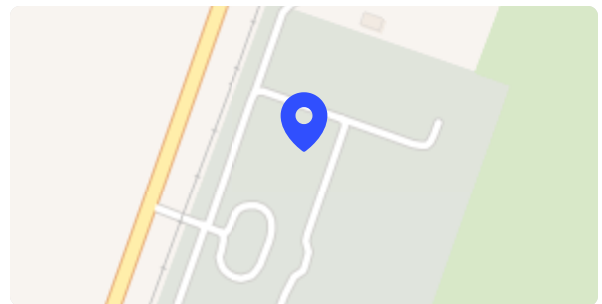
