Patricia Huhn of Scappoose, Oregon, passed away November 24, 2023, at the age of 79. She was born December 14, 1943, in Cleveland, Ohio to Robert and Mary (Straniero) Palazzo. Patti lived in Cleveland, Overland Park, Kansas, and Dallas where she attended Southern Methodist University (SMU) and earned a Bachelor's in English Literature from the North Texas State University before moving to Kansas and then Oregon.

After moving to Oregon, she was hired by Tektronix to work in the mail room, was quickly promoted to secretary in the logic analyzer division and then later a customer service representative. Patti retired after 30 years with the company. She met her husband, Andy Huhn, at Tektronix and they were married February 16, 1973, in Portland.
