# **Maria Gilberta Escobar**

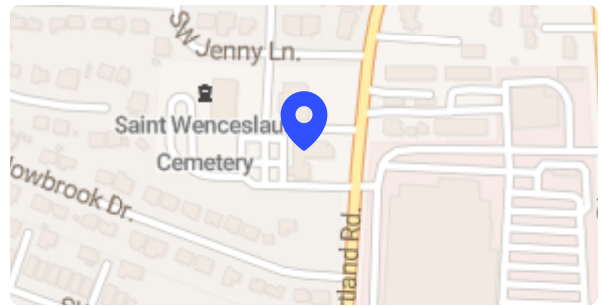

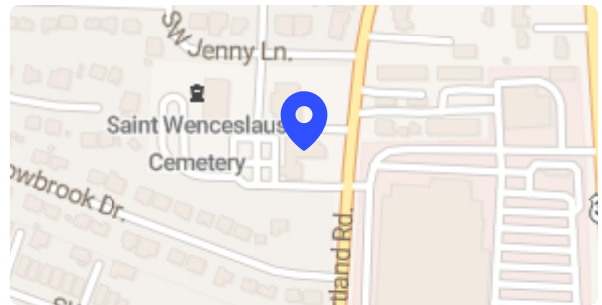

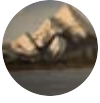
