In lieu of flowers, donations in remembrance of Winona can be made to First Evangelical Lutheran Church or The American Parkinson Disease Association.



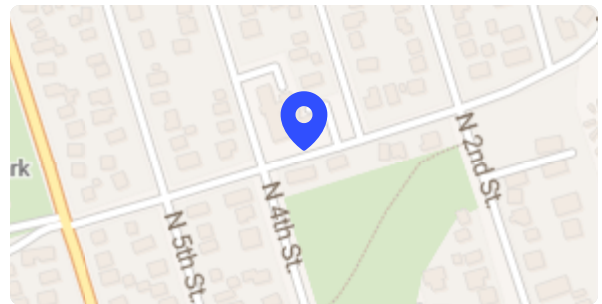

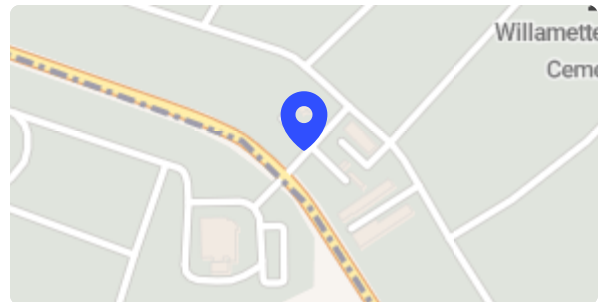

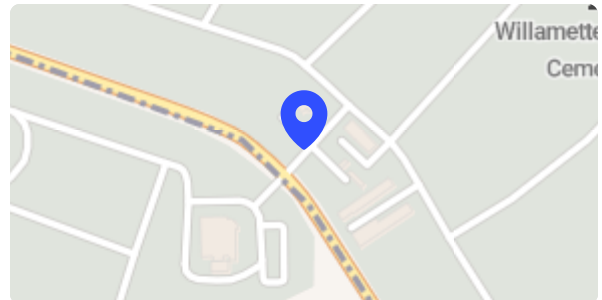
